Road Trains

The planned road train route as accepted by Council shall apply subject to the following conditions:-

- a. 80km speed restrictions apply whilst loaded and unloaded.
- b. Legal loading limits per axle.
- c. Council's Technical Services & Works Committee will hold the right to cancel or suspend all permits at any given time.

Roadside Driveway Clearance

Landholders are permitted to clear roadside driveway and farm entrances up to a maximum of 15 metres either side from driveway edges along the length of the road and up to 12 metres from the road.

Road Reserve Permits

Council's may provide a permit (to be assessed on an individual basis) for the cropping and depasturing of animals on roads subject to approval and payment of the required fee.

Should an adjacent landowner hold a permit for use of a road and intends grazing stock on the adjacent land, Council requires the landholder to fence his land along the adjoining boundary.

Council will also consider applications for the purchase of unused rural road reserves within its district, with any applications received to be considered individually and decisions based on the merits of the particular circumstance.

Unwanted Underground Fuel Storage Tanks on Road Reserves

Any underground fuel storage tank located in/on Council land (footpath/road reserve), which is not required for the supply of fuel to the public must be removed from the ground within six (6) months from the date from which the non use commenced. The work of removing the tank must include all requirements of the Department of Work Place Services in relation to site safety, soil contamination, storage of the empty tank and consolidation of the site. The reinstatement of the site must be carried out to Council satisfaction and at the total cost to the owner of the tank.

Furthermore, Council may at its discretion serve notice on any person who may own any abandoned underground fuel storage tank which may be located in/on Council land (road reserve/footpath) for the removal of that tank under the time requirements that Council must specify in the notice.
