Aims & Objectives

To give Council's Officers direction.

Policy Detail

Upon receipt of notification of an appeal to the Environment, Resources and Development Court against a decision of Council or one of its delegates, Council's solicitor(s) shall be engaged to prepare the necessary evidence for Council in the appeal.

Council's solicitor(s) shall be instructed as to the names of suitable persons to be called as expert witnesses before the Environment, Resources and Development Court.

Where an appeal is referred to a conference to be held pursuant to the Environment, Resources and Development Court Act 1993 council shall represent at the conference.

Council's representative(s) at a conference held pursuant to the Environment, Resources and Development Court Act 1993 shall be authorised to enter into binding agreements at the conference only in so far as they effect minor modifications to conditions of consent which will not in the representative's opinion significantly vary the intent of the control sought by the conditions of consent.
